Dressage

The two days will run the same as previous dressage championships with 3 divisions:

Junior Level 1 (14 years and under*) Intermediate Level 2 (18 years and under*) * as at 1st August 2021 & Senior Level 3 (24 years and under as at 20th January 2022).

2 tests with the same 6 judges at both events in the north & south island.

Show Jumping

Area Team to comprise of six riders, three in each ring.

RING 1 - PONY or HACK Round 1 - 1.05m, Round 2 - 1.10m - RING 2 PONY or HACK Round 1 – 1.10m, Round 2 - 1.15m

Team will be selected based on previous showjumping results at the height you wish to be considered for.

- This will be a similar competition to the HOY event.
 - The Jumping arena, tracks and types of fences will be replicated at both NI and SI week so overall national team placings can be calculated.
 - Six riders constitute a team. Three riders in each Ring. Four scores to count
 - One mount per rider.
 - **Round 1 All teams**
 - Ring 1 - 1.05m Ring 2 - 1.10m Speed - 325m/min
 - **Round 2 The number of teams may be reduced**
 - The discard score riders need not start if their effort will not affect the result.
 - The course may be shortened
 - Ring 1 – increase to 1.10m Ring 2 - increase to 1.15m Speed - 350m/min
 - Reverse team order – 1.10m to jump first
